COUNTY SEAT: Vicksburg

ORIGIN OF NAME: Joseph Warren, hero of the Revolution.

ORGANIZED AS COUNTY: December 22, 1809

LAND AREA: 597 sq. miles

MEMORIAL NOTES: Seventh Mississippi county to organize. Warren County was organized 11 years following the organization of the Mississippi Territory and 8 years before Mississippi was admitted to the Union. Robert Williams was Mississippi Territorial Governor and Thomas Jefferson was President of the U.S. Abraham Lincoln was born February 12, 1809 in Hodgenville, Kentucky.
