Jackson MPO Call for Projects

The Jackson Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is announcing a “Call for Projects” for consideration of funding for Transportation Alternatives (TA) funds available to eligible applicants.

Available Funds:

Funding is being made available to the Jackson MPO through the recent Transportation Bill, Fixing America’s Surface Transportation (FAST) Act. The amount of TA funding available is **\$2,000,000**.

Evaluation Criteria & Application Document:

All proposals seeking funding will be evaluated and prioritized according to the adopted Project Submittal Guidelines. Blank applications can be obtained by contacting MPO staff or visiting the MPO’s website, <http://www.cmpdd.org/transportation-alternatives-program-tap/>.

Submission Instructions:

Submit one (1) original proposal with three (3) copies of all required documentation in a sealed envelope. Each proposal should be typed on letter size paper bound in a three-prong or 3-ring binder. All proposals must include the following:

- Cover letter from the principal elected official or chief executive (The cover letter must include name and contact information of person responsible for filling out the application)
- Completed application
- An appendix containing all required attachments such as matching funds resolution, project readiness supporting documentation, a project map, and any additional documentation that helps support the project

All proposals must be received by the Central Mississippi Planning and Development District (CMPDD) through mail or hand-delivery **by 4:30 P.M., Friday, March 29, 2019**. *All applications received after the deadline will be rejected.*
