Notice of Proposed Amendments to the Jackson Urbanized Area Transportation Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2023 through 2026

The Central Mississippi Planning & Development District (CMPDD) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible – together with the Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) and operators of public transit in the area (JTRAN) – for coordinating a Federally-mandated Transportation Planning Process for the Jackson Urbanized Area. One of the responsibilities of the MPO is to prepare a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) containing transportation projects proposed by MDOT, JTRAN, and municipalities and counties in the metropolitan area. The TIP list all transportation related projects receiving federal transportation funding within the MPO area as well as regionally significant projects.

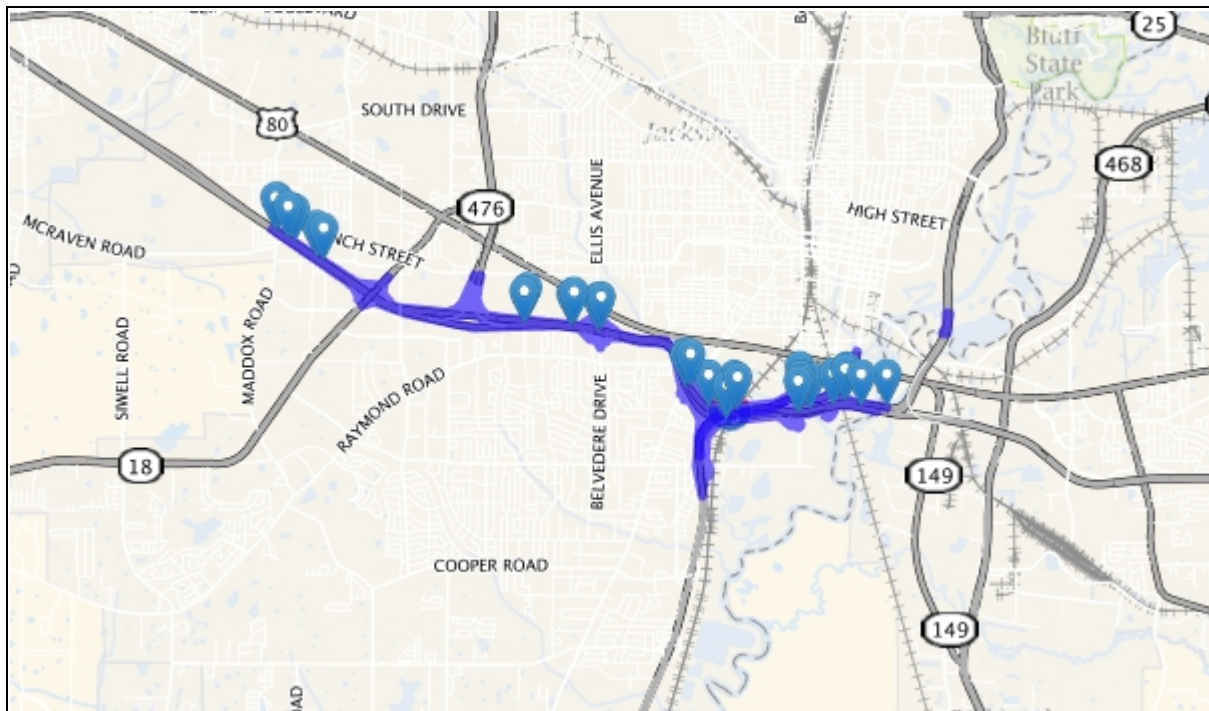
