DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES PROVIDED

Adult Day Care

A place for aged and disabled individuals with serious health problems or impairments to go during the day with recreational activities, personal care supervision, nutrition, limited health care and the opportunity to interact socially with other people in the group or individual activities. The center cares for adults four or more hours while a family member works or enjoys respite from their role as caretaker.

Case Management

The case managers identify the needs of elderly individuals through a comprehensive assessment completed in the homes of potential clients. A care plan is developed based on the individuals needs. Services are coordinated and monitored to individuals at risk for institutionalization in an effort to provide continuity of care.

Congregate Meals

A congregate meal is a nutritionally balanced meal served in a specific location such as a community or senior care center. The meals are primarily for the mobile seniors and done in a group setting.

Elder Abuse/Neglect/Exploitation Prevention

This program provides information to vulnerable adults in effort to prevent abuse, neglect or exploitation.

Emergency Services

A social, financial and supportive program to assist elderly individuals through a crisis or a life threatening, unexpected emergency situation which demands or requires immediate action or intervention.

Home Delivered Meals

A nutritionally balanced meal delivered to the homes of those unable to leave home without assistance. These persons are homebound and most are receiving case management services.

Homemaker Services

A support service that is provided in the home by a trained homemaker that involves education and/or provision of home management tasks in order to assist in strengthening family life, promoting self sufficiency and enhancing quality of life.

Institutional Respite

Services provided to individuals unable to care for themselves, furnished on a short term basis because of the absence or need for relief of those persons normally providing the care.

Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program

Ombudsman services are those that relate to the well being of institutionalized elderly persons. Services include investigation and resolution of complaints, advocacy and development of programs to ensure the quality of life for residents of long term care facilities.

Long-Term Care Alternatives Program

This program provides information, education, and referral sources for elderly and/or disabled adults who considering long term care.

Medicaid Waiver Program

The Elderly and Disabled waiver provides services to individuals who, but for the provision of such services, would require the level of care found in a nursing facility.

Mississippi Insurance Counseling and Assistance Program

A counseling program designed to answer elderly or disabled citizens' questions about health insurance (Medicare, Medicaid, Medicare Supplement and Long-Term Care Insurance, and HMO's).

Senior Community Service Employment Program, Title V

This program is designed to provide and promote useful part-time opportunities in community service employment, mainly for low-income person(s) who are 55 years of age or older. This program also assists and promotes the transition of enrollees to private or unsubsidized employment to the extent feasible.

Transportation

The travel of eligible older individuals to and from community resources for the purpose of obtaining needed services or goods.

Emergency Response

A 24 hour/7days a week monitoring device that transmit signals to a call center for help or assistance if needed from emergency personnel (e.g. police dept. fire dept. or ambulance)

CASE MANAGEMENT

Case managers are registered nurses and licensed social workers that identify the needs of elderly and/or disabled through a comprehensive assessment completed in the homes of potential clients. The assessment is followed by the development of a care plan, then approval of the care plan by the Division of Medicaid. The case managers arrange for the approved services and provides ongoing monitoring and adjustment to ensure proper care.

NATIONAL FAMILY CAREGIVERS PROGRAM

A caregiver is someone who provides care to an individual who is no longer able to take care of him or herself.

The National Family Caregiver Program offers the following services based upon eligibility. The program is administered through the Area Agency on Aging which is housed within the Central Mississippi Planning and Development District.

Services Offered:

1. Information and Assistance
2. In-Home Respite and Adult Day Care Respite
3. Supplemental Services (Grab bars, Ramps, Diapers, Blue Pads and Protective Undergarments).
4. Home safety devices (Smoke Detectors)

Eligibility:

Respite services limited to the following:

Family caregiver(s) of older adults 60 years and older

Caregiver and older adults(s) must reside together

Grandparents(s) and/or relative caregivers who are sole caregivers of those who are affected by mental retardation or have a developmental disabilities

Eligibility Priority:

1st - Person(s) in the greatest social and economical need

2nd - Older individuals who are providing care and support to a person with mental retardation or related developmental disabilities

EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR OLDER ADULTS

Emergency Services are social, financial and supportive assistance to help elderly individuals through a crisis, life threatening or unexpected emergency situation. These situations at times can demand or require immediate actions or intervention. Emergency services can be classified as temporary, short-term or extended.
