College Scholarship Application Guide

- Scholarship Awards will be applicable to the 2018-2019 school year
- Two (2) scholarships totaling \$1,000.00 each will be awarded to two (2) students for the 2018/2019 year
- Scholarships are available to individuals entering a college in any year (Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior) as an undergraduate
- Community Colleges are applicable for this scholarship
- No student will be eligible to receive more than one (1) CMMA scholarship per lifetime
- Students may utilize scholarship funds to cover tuition, books or fees
- Mayors may distribute application forms in their community (counties included in the CMMA area only) beginning November 1, 2017
- Applications can be completed and submitted to the address found at the end of the application OR applications can be completed and submitted online at the following link <http://www.cmpdd.org/images/cmms-scholarship-guide-and-application-1.pdf>
- Applications must be received by the Central Mississippi Planning and Development District no later than January 31, 2018 (postmarked)
- The CMMA will appoint an independent committee to review applications and select scholarship recipients
- Following review and rating of all applications, the top five applicants will be notified of and invited to an interview with the appointed independent committee.
- Scholarship awards will be announced no later than April 1, 2018 for the 2018/2019 school year.
