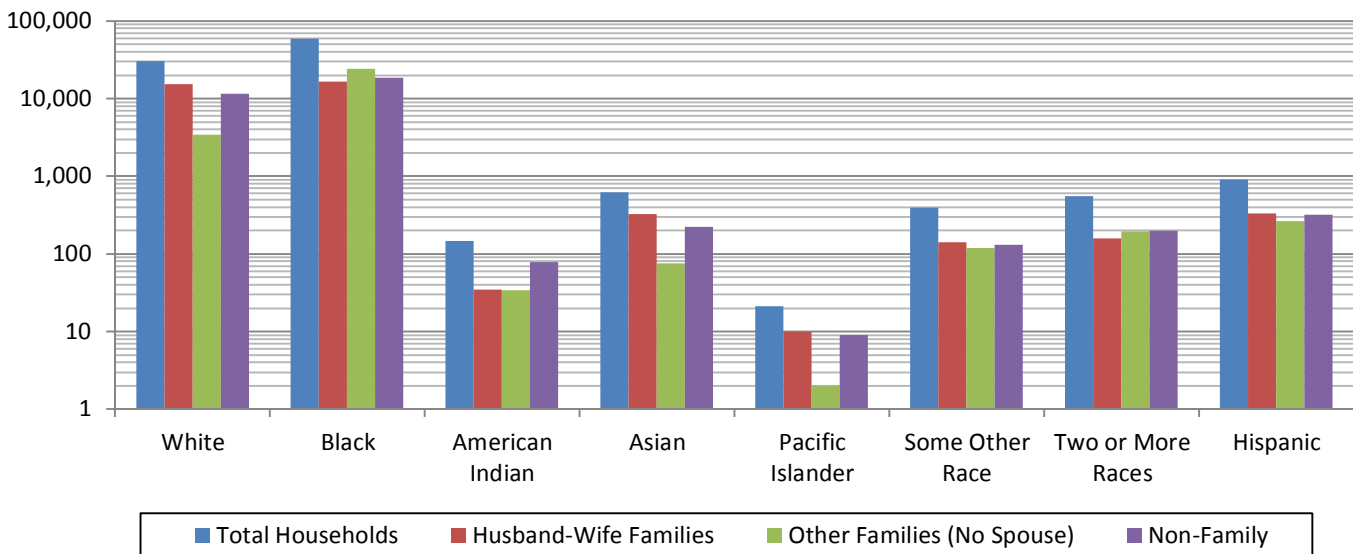

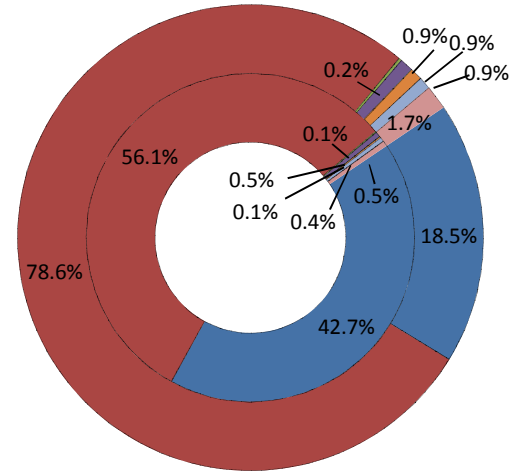

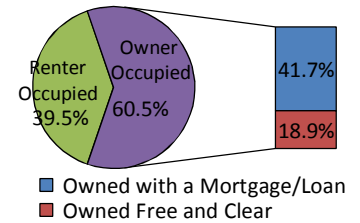
### Housing Units by Race of Householder



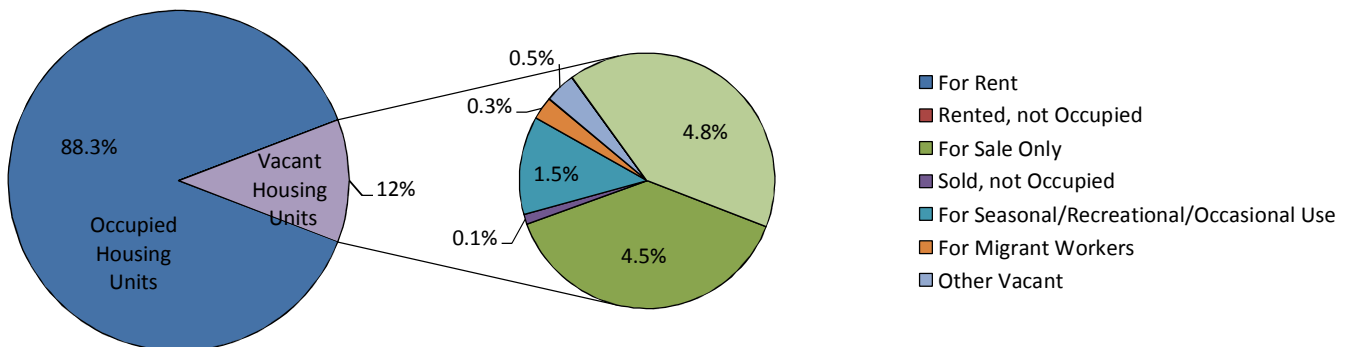
