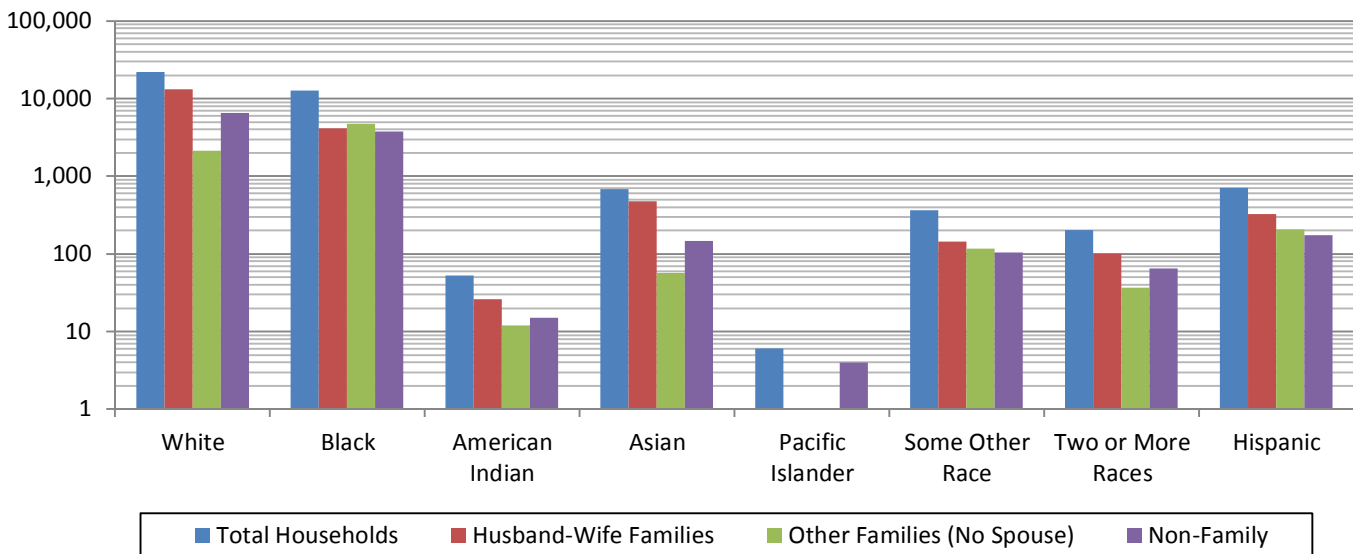

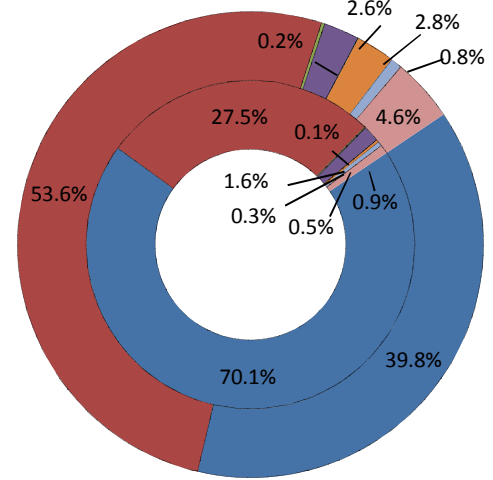

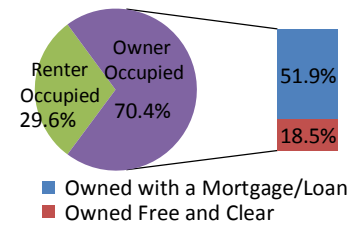
Housing Units by Race of Householder



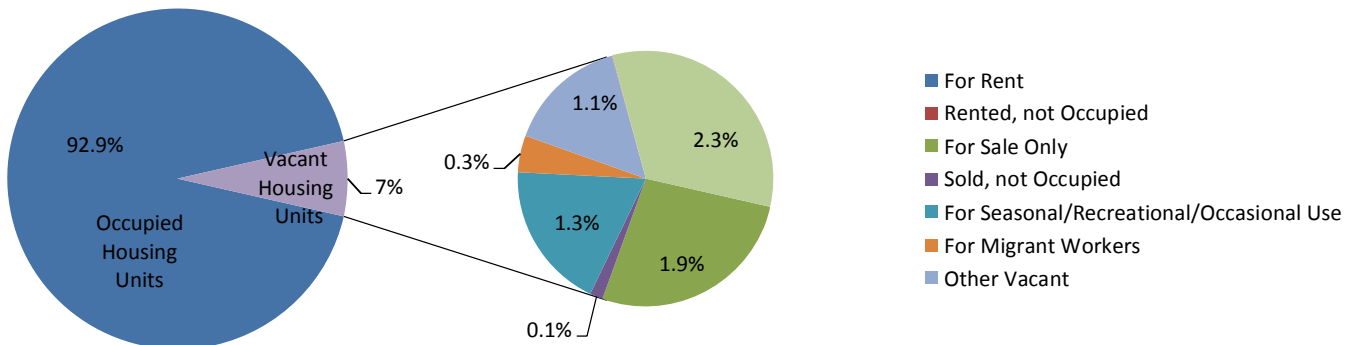
