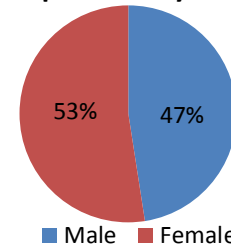

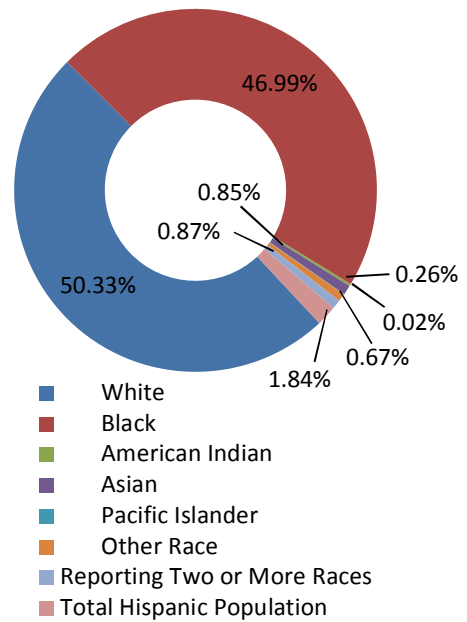

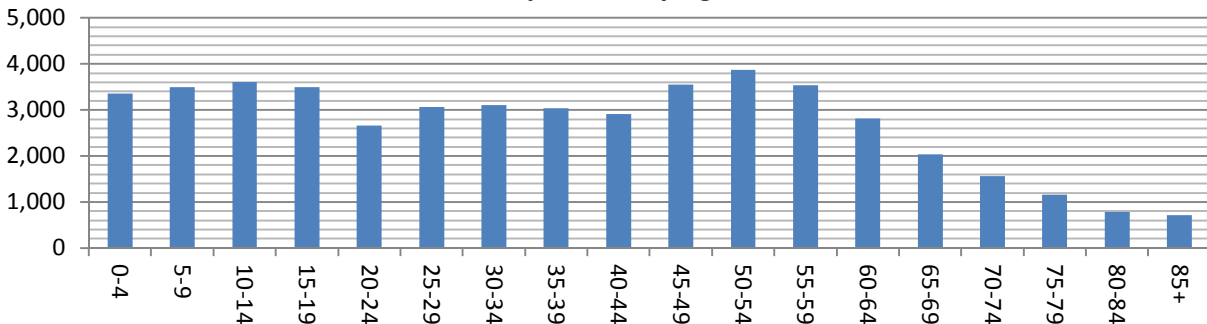

**Population by Age**



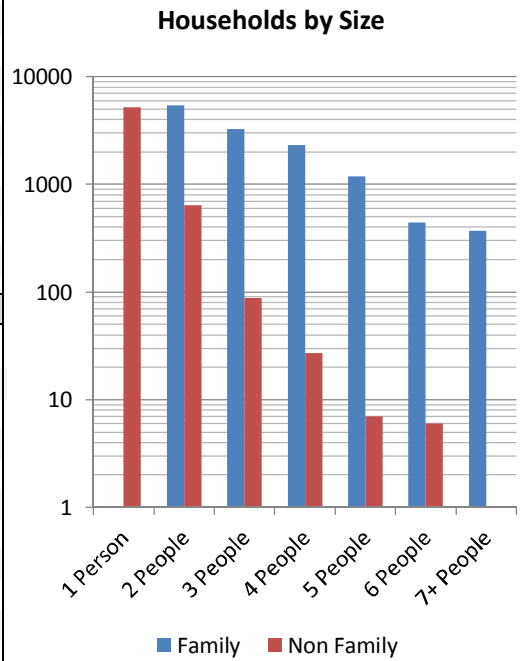

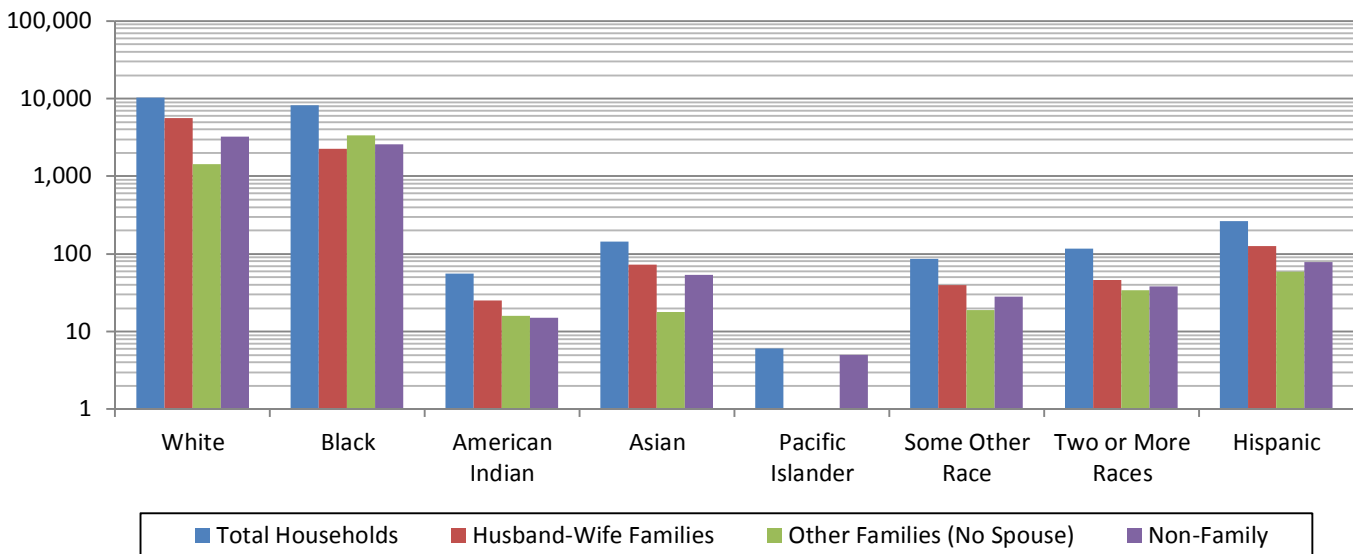

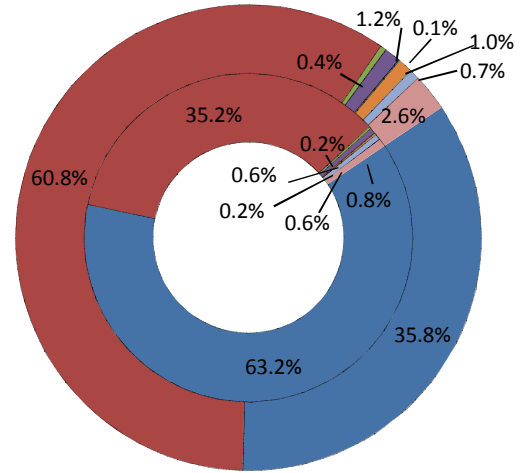

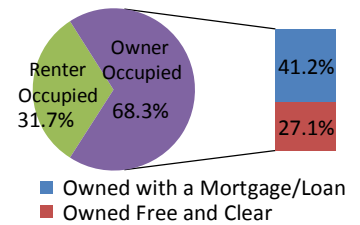
### Housing Units by Race of Householder



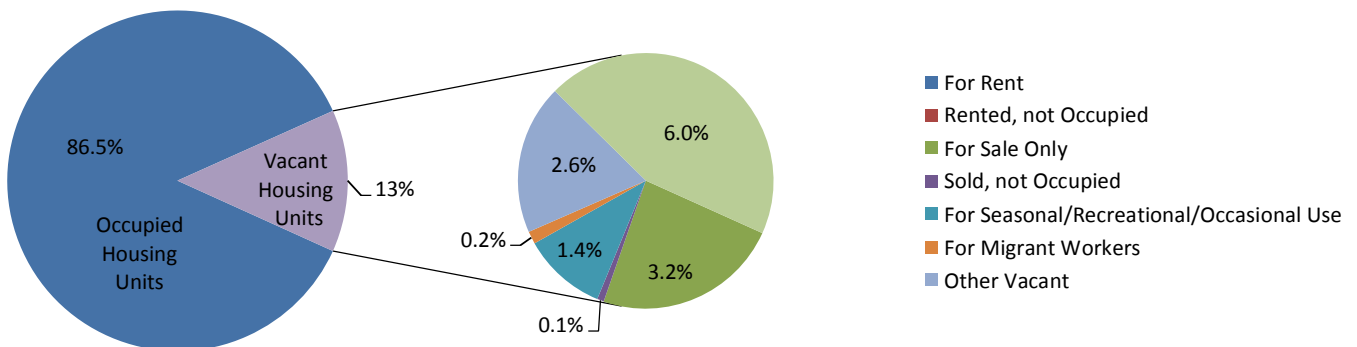
