

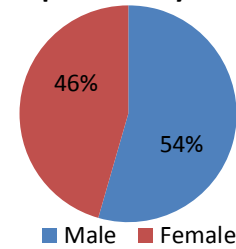

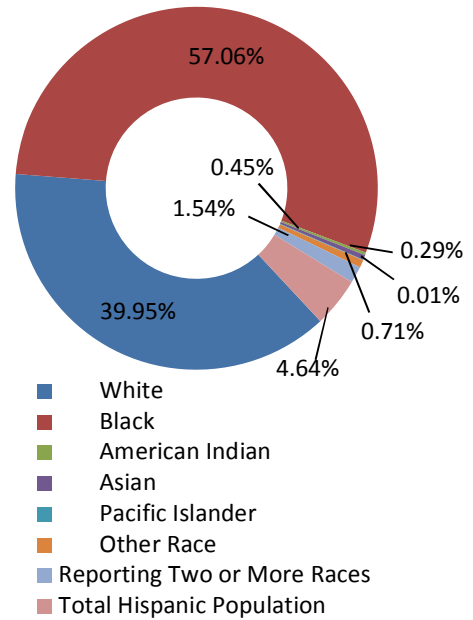

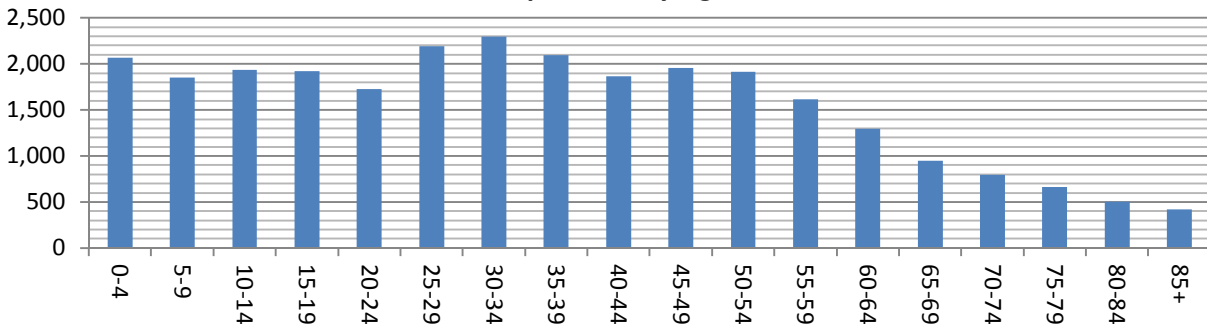

Population by Age



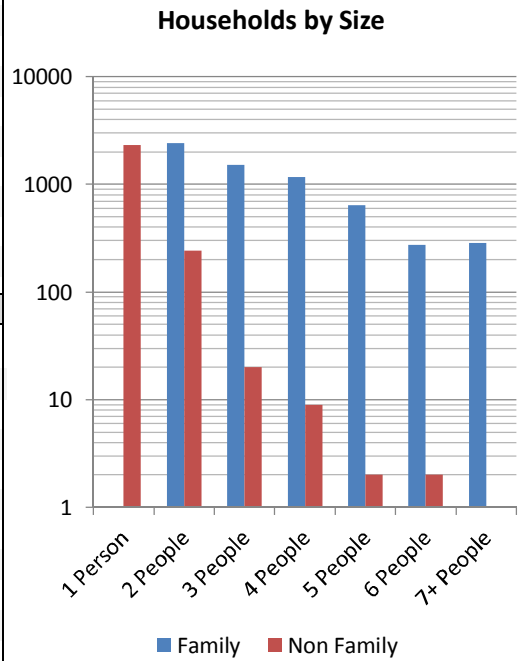

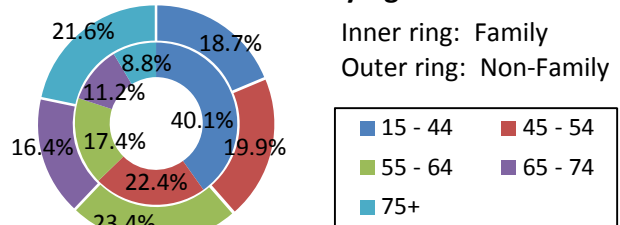

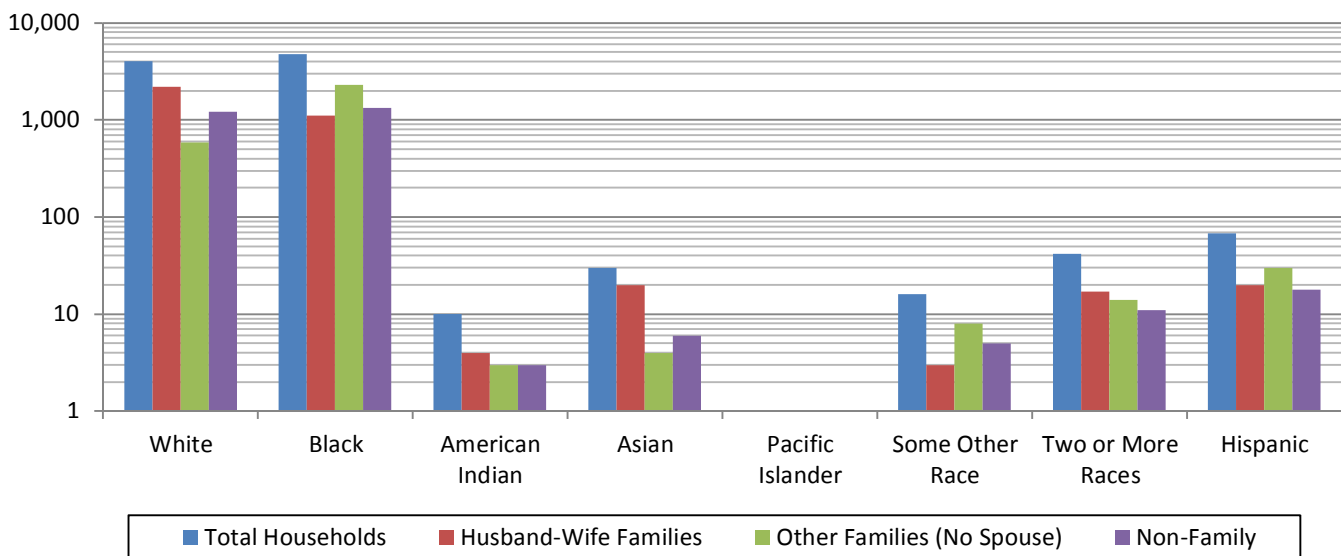
Households by Age of Householder

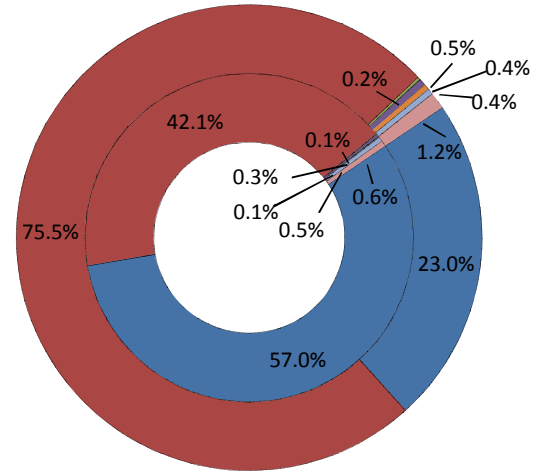

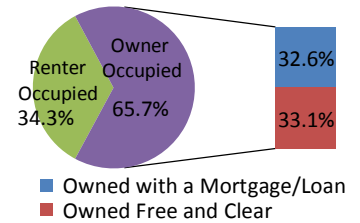
Housing Units by Race of Householder



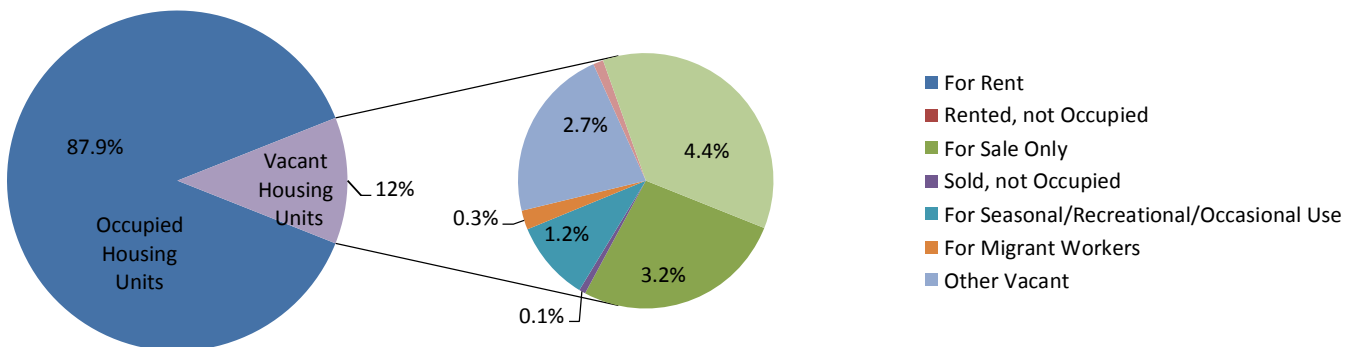
